



Decentralized, Status neutral, Stakeholder-engaged, post-incarceration intervention for people with and at risk for HIV: The DEST2nation Study

Goal: To develop an effective, person-centered, low-barrier, comprehensive model of post-incarceration care for people involved with the criminal legal system with and at risk for HIV

Funding: NIH/NIDA R61/R33





Timeline

Key findings from CAB and stakeholder meetings


- **Patient level barriers:**
 - Challenges with linkage to care (HIV, substance use, mental health)
 - Discontinuity in post-incarceration period, medical mistrust, transportation
- **CBO level barriers:**
 - Challenges with inter-departmental communication
 - Limited HIV-focused education including treatment + prevention options
- **How the DEST2nation model fits:**
 - Peer navigator as central component
 - Enhance coordination within CBO services as well as testing and linkage to HIV treatment and prevention care

DEST2nation RCT (R33 phase)

- **Recruitment goal N=420** (226 PWH; 194 at risk)
- **Inclusion criteria:** 1) Partnering CBO clients, 2) >18 years old, 3) current or past SUD, 3) PWH or at-risk, 5) fluent in English or Spanish, 5) residents of NYC, NJ (Essex & Hudson Counties), or PA (Philadelphia County), and 6) released from jail or prison within 30 days.
- **Exclusion criteria:** 1) inability to provide informed consent, 2) inability to complete study visits over 12 months, 3) current or prior psychotic disorder.

Budgeted items

- **Costs covered by Einstein**
 - **Community Advisory Board:** \$50/hour for each 2-hour CAB
 - **Stakeholders:** \$85/hour for each 3-hour meeting
 - **Peer navigator**
 - **Research participant compensation:**
 - \$50 incentive + \$ local travel for attending and completing 5 study visits
 - Study phone
 - **HIV testing supplies**
